Club Background

The Hi-Mar Striper Club is the premier Striped Bass fishing club in New Jersey. Most of our members focus their fishing in the Raritan Bay and Sandy Hook waters. The club membership includes the area's best charter captains, family recreational fisherman, and individuals who want to make a difference in preserving our precious fishery for generations to come.

Throughout it's almost forty years of existence, various Hi-Mar members were the innovators of several effective bass catching techniques with plugs and spoons. Members of the club are also pioneers in developing such effective techniques as worming for bass, live lining bunker, chunking Flynn's Knoll, light tackle angling for bass and nighttime plug trolling in the Sandy Hook Rips.

The club operates a fishing Flea Market and Spring & Fall Striped Bass fishing tournaments annually, utilizing the proceeds to fund it's giving to charitable causes.

Club Meetings

The Hi-Mar striper club meets the first Tuesday of the month at Bahrs Landing Restaurant in Highlands (7:30 P.M.). The meeting usually consists of a fishing seminar, a review of pending legislations, a review of environmental issues, a status report from various standing committees, who won the quarterly member contest for ten species, and best of all, there's a series of fishing reports from several of the top striped bass anglers in the area. The club membership includes some top notch local recreational and charter captains who are available to share a wealth of fishing knowledge at each meeting.

All captains are very open and eager to help other fellow members increase their catch with new methods and current "hot spots". New members don't have to own a boat as they can team up with a current member to help them learn the waters, determine where the local fish species reside, and finally, which methods work best.

Hi-Mar's Moral Standpoint

Hi-Mar is a member and proud supporter of the Jersey Coast Anglers Association (JCAA), New Jersey Outdoor Alliance (NJOA), American Littoral Society, Menhaden Defenders, Save the Summer Flounder Fishery Fund (SSFFF), NJ Reef Rescue and the Recreational Fishing Alliance (RFA). Avoiding passive membership in these organizations, Hi-Mar members played an important role in the Menhaden Project which helped bring public attention to the problem of over harvesting bunker by netters. Thanks to the dedication and hard work of our members we have eliminated the bunker reduction boats from our waters.
